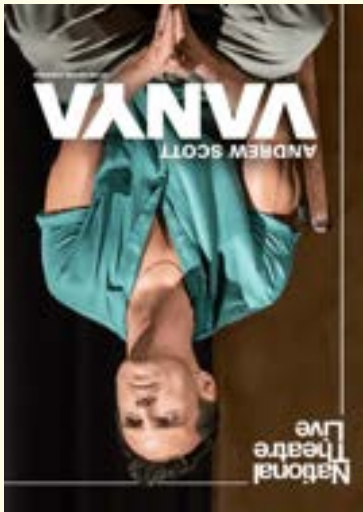
**Join us**

We are located on the Canterbury/Herne Bay/Whitstable (Triangle) bus route, with a stop directly outside the Playhouse.

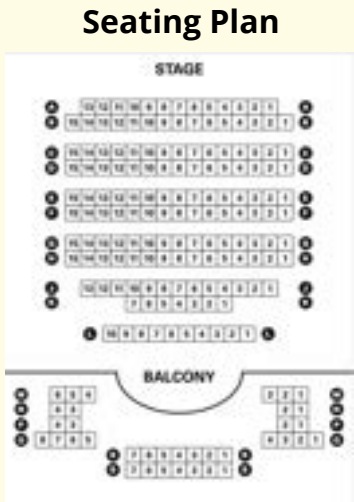

## Amadeus

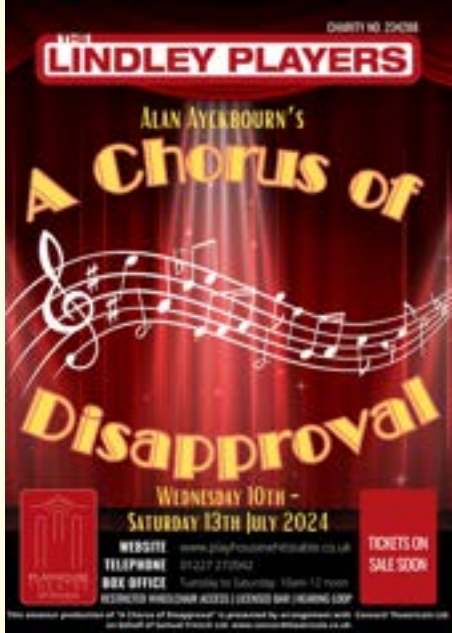
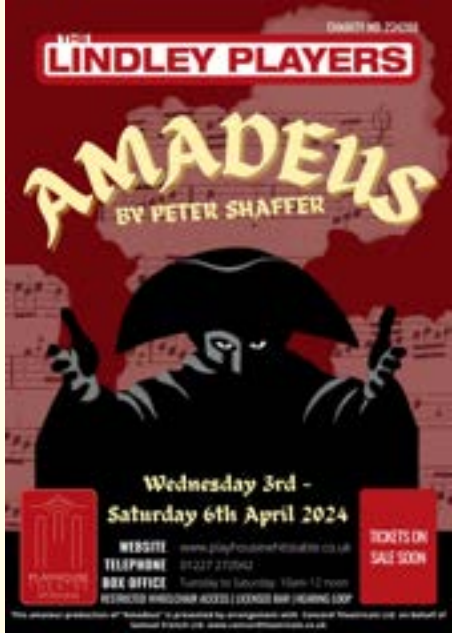
Salieri has pledged to dedicate his life to composing music in the name of God, until he hears of a genius new composer on the scene, Mozart.

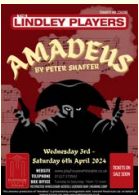

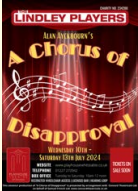
